Hoxne Neighbourhood Plan 2022 - 2037 Referendum Information Statement



A referendum relating to the adoption of the Hoxne Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 4 April 2024

The 'Hoxne Neighbourhood Plan 2022 - 2037' contains planning policies for the use and development of land within the designated area (the parish). There is a statutory process which must be followed before this Plan can be 'made' (adopted). This involves holding a referendum, which will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections.

Those entitled to vote will be asked to answer 'yes' or 'no' to the following question:

'Do you want Mid Suffolk District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Hoxne to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

If more than 50% of the cast votes are 'yes', Mid Suffolk District Council will be legally obliged to 'make' (adopt) this plan as part of its development framework.

A person is entitled to vote in this referendum if;

- He or She is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- He or She has an address at which they are registered to vote within the referendum area and are over the age of 18 years on the date of poll.

The referendum area is identical to that originally designated as the Neighbourhood Plan Area and follows the parish boundary. A map of the area can be found within the referendum version of the Plan (see links below).

Expenses can be incurred by an individual or body during the referendum period for referendum purposes but are subject to a limit calculated to be £2,403.06

The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which this limit has been calculated is 696 (*figure correct at time of publication*).
